

Explorer Scout Climbing Club

Who is the club for?

The club is aimed primarily at Explorer Scouts and Senior Section Guides but attendance is welcomed from adult members who wish to improve their own climbing skills or who would like to assist with the running of club sessions.

How good a climber do I have to be to join?

There is no restriction to anyone whatever their level of experience and expertise. We are happy for individuals who are complete novices to come along but to benefit from the club you must be sure in your own mind that you are happy climbing at heights up to 30 metres.

When and where will the club meet?

We will meet at various venues both indoors and out. There will be at least one meeting per month from October to April. In most cases meetings will take place on a Sunday and depending on the venue will be for half a day or a full day. Whenever possible meetings will be at natural rock crags with indoor climbing venues being used as a wet weather alternative.

How will members know details of meetings?

Full details of each meeting will then be e-mailed (or posted if required) to all registered members. This will be done approximately a fortnight before each meeting.
